

MUSIC Jason Meyer

At 16 years old Jason Meyer was the youngest student to be accepted at the Universty of Hartford in Violin and Composition.

After a career in USA - he was concertmaster of The Boston Opera, violinist for the Boston Symphony Orchestra (under Seiji Ozawa) and the Boston Pops Esplanade Orchestra (under John Williams), professor of chamber music at New England Conservatory - he decided to settle in France. There, he rapidly became concertmaster of l'Opéra de Troyes, l'Opéra de Toulon, l'Orchestre Pasdeloup, l'Ensemble 2e2m, l'Orchestre Symphonique de Tours. As a composer, he works for theatre, for the Klezmer music group Yankele, for advertisements: his composition for Carven has been nominated for an award in 2014. He co-founded the piano trio, Le Trio de Lutèce, which was invited three times to perform at the prestigious Cambridge (England) International Chamber Music Festival. In 2013, he was the guest for the radio broadcast «Les Traverses du temps» (Marcel Quillévéré – France Musique) He has also directed at the Philharmonie de Paris.
